2014 DODGE RAM 5500 HD

Council approved the purchase of a 2014 RAM 5500 SLT 4WD with box and hoist from Driving Force.

WATERWORKS RATE POLICY & CAPITAL INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The 2016 Waterworks Rate Policy and Capital Investment Strategy was approved. The Town's current Utility Rate Policy supports gradual annual rate increases in order to maintain pace with operating costs and eventually reach a goal of an annual utility surplus of \$100,000 to be set aside annually as reserves for future utility capital projects. Future capital projects include renewal of No. 1 and No. 4 sewer lift stations and dredging of the Raw Water Reservoir, along with commissioning of a new raw water pumphouse and reservoir.

SIDEWALK PROJECT

The Town will call for proposals for the works specified by Bullée Consulting Ltd. respecting the proposed Main Street and 4th Avenue sidewalk improvements.

LANE SURVEY UPDATE

Council acknowledged the update on cleanup orders issued under the June 13, 2016 Lane Survey and the Town will follow up for required work to be completed under the authority of the Municipalities Act where necessary.

WSI COURSE RE-IMBURSEMENT – POOL POLICY

Council confirmed the existing policy relating to re-imburement of the Water Safety Instructor course training for Pool staff.
