SAMA RESPONSE – INDUSTRIAL ASSESSMENT ISSUES

Council acknowledged response from SAMA's Industrial division relating to assessment errors resulting in extremely significant assessment adjustment agreements being required for Weyerhaeuser Mill and Timberland properties.

CLEAN WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE FUND PROGRAM - CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

Council approved and authorized the Mayor and CAO to execute the Provincial/Federal Agreement for the Water Reservoir Pumphouse Project under the Clean Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Fund Program.
