LANDFILL INSPECTION REPORT RESPONSE

Council acknowledged the Administration's response to the Action Items outlined in SK Environment's June 5th Landfill Inspection Report.

KUSHNIRUK – 500 BLOCK ALBERT ST. SWALE REQUEST

Council acknowledged request for installation of swales or curb and gutter on the East side of the 500 Block of Albert Street and will advise we can develop an estimate for that type of improvement work for consideration by the residents, however, it would not be a 2018 project. It was also noted the curb and gutter projects are typically classified as Local Improvements whereby costs of the frontage improvements are borne by the benefitting property owners.
