**DEPUTY MAYOR**

**MOBILE HOME TENDERS**

Council acknowledged that no tenders were received to date on the seized Knight mobile home and the administration was authorized to affect a sale of the property for any reasonable offer.

**SIDEWALK PROJECT PROPOSALS**

Council acknowledged the three different proposals received for the 2016 sidewalk project and the proposal from Jacob Baerg was accepted for forming and placement of concrete. The Town will arrange all excavation, grade preparation and backfill separately.

**SHOP PROJECT – ELECTRICAL CONTRACT PROPOSALS**

Correspondence received from Darren Zimmerman of Paradise Electric was acknowledged, and the Town will finalize the completion of a call for electrical proposals on the Town Shop expansion project to close at noon Friday, July 29, 2016.

**PREMIER TECH HORTICULTURE**

Council approved the finalized lease document with Premier Tech Horticulture for a portion of the OSB 1000 Warehouse Building located on Parcel P, Plan 101956721 for a one (1) year term. Premier will be using the site to do additional product and market testing based on peat reserves under lease to them in the Hudson Bay area.
