DRAFT TOWN/R.M. – INTER-MUNICIPAL TAX SHARING AGREEMENT

Council approved the Draft Inter-Municipal Tax Sharing Agreement as recommended by the Town's solicitor.

MOA – USW – 2017 – 2019

Council approved the March 2, 2017 Memorandum of Agreement between the United Steel Workers and the Town of Hudson Bay outlining articles agreed to for amendment of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties as agreed to by the Town's Negotiating Committee. The agreement covers a three (3) year term 2017 – 2019.

The Town will meet with Sheldon Stechyshyn, SAMA Regional Manager, at noon on March 28, 2017 to receive a presentation of the 2017 Assessment Revaluation.

PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEE

Council acknowledged the Summary of Applications for the Public Works employee position and a committee of Mayor McCaffery, Deputy Mayor Cadrain, Councilors Palko or Barker, CAO and Director of Public Works were authorized to complete the hiring process. Twenty seven (27) applications were received.

ROTARY EVENTS

Council approved the temporary street closures for the following Rotary Club events:

SARRC – OPERATING AGREEMENT

Council approved the renewal of the EcoCentre Operating Agreement with the Saskatchewan Association for Resource Recovery Corp. for the term January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2021. The agreement covers the EcoCentre oil, antifreeze and container recycling facility at the Waste Disposal Site.

RESIDENTIAL LOT PRICING

Based on current assessment appraisal information, the Town will immediately increase residential lot prices by 10% per year for the next 4 years starting with the 2017 year.
