**CANSHALE UPDATE**

Representatives Chris Hopkins, Nick Pohorelic and Chris Yellowega from Canshale provided a project update to Council. Exploration permits have been converted to leases. With receipt of the Golden Plain leases, Canshale has commenced an in-depth planning program. In it they are uniquely applying proven, modern processes to ensure responsible potential development of this exciting resource.

**CENSUS APPEAL RESULTS**

Council acknowledged results of our official appeal of the 2016 census count resulting in corrections increasing private dwelling count from 779 to 801 and population count from 1397 to 1436.

**FIR RIVER DREDGING – PERMIT RENEWAL**
