FIR RIVER BRIDGE

Estimates will be requested from HB Construction for repair of the Fir River bridge located South of SE5-45-3-W2. Although this bridge is located on a roadway under the Town's jurisdiction it serves only residents of the Rural Municipality and therefore an agreement with the R.M. will be required prior to carrying out any work on the bridge.

NESD – STEWART HAWKE PROPERTY AGREEMENT

Council approved the sale agreement between the North East School Division and Town of Hudson Bay respecting the Stewart Hawke property Block 24, Plan No. CT2889 and the Mayor and Administrator were authorized to execute same. The Town has agreed to accept the property along with a payment to offset future potential demolition costs.

OH & S INSPECTION REPORT – AUGUST 16, 2018

Council acknowledged the August 16, 2018 OH & S Inspection Report and the CAO will respond appropriately respecting address of the noted contraventions.

LIFT STATION NO. 1 – UPGRADE OPTIONS

The Town will request Bullée Consulting complete an updated assessment of options relating to upgrade of the No. 1 Lift Station. The Main Lift Station is the Town's priority infrastructure project at this time.

BCL – LANDFILL LEACHATE COLLECTION & DISPOSAL SYSTEM DESIGN

Council acknowledged the August 27, 2018 Landfill Leachate Collection and Disposal System Design Report and the Town will submit to the Ministry of Environment for approval.

R.M. WASTE DISPOSAL 2018 FEES

The Town will invoice the R.M. of Hudson Bay #394 for their annual share of the Waste Disposal Site operation and ongoing development costs.

INVASIVE PLANTS/UNLAWFUL DUMPING

The Town will install additional "No Dumping" signs along Albert and Donald Street back alleys.

CHURCHILL RAIL LINE

The Town will participate in the lobby for use of the Churchill Rail line and re-opening of CN subdivision to Tisdale.

POOL FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE – FUTURE PLANS

Council acknowledged the fundraising efforts to date and the Town will continue investigations of future options.

HB COMMUNITY SCHOOL – ARENA USAGE

Council approved request of the Hudson Bay Community School for use of the Arena for school programs.
