BUDGET REVIEW

The August 31, 2015 Budget Review Summary document was acknowledged. The Town is basically anticipating a balanced operating year, plus the planned completion of several large capital projects, including paving and expansion of the Town Shop and Fire Hall within 2015 capital allocations.
