BYLAW NO. 179

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE OF FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES IN THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY

The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts:

- 1. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) "FIREARM" means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any firearm that is capable of firing bullets in rapid succession during one pressure of the trigger.
 - (b) "PROJECTILE PROPELLING INSTRUMENT" means catapults, air guns or other projectile propelling instruments.
 - (c) "EXPLOSIVE" means anything, or part thereof, used or intended to be used, or adapted to cause or aiding in causing, an explosion in or with an explosive substance.
- 2. No person shall discharge a firearm within the limits of the Town of Hudson Bay.
- 3. No person shall discharge, employ or use a projectile propelling instrument capable of killing or maiming within the limits of the Town of Hudson Bay.
- 4. No person shall cause an explosion or employ the use of explosive substances within the limits of the Town of Hudson Bay.
- 5. This bylaw shall not apply to police officers or other employees of the Town in the discharge of their duties.
- 6. Any person found guilty of any infraction of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Hudson Bay.
- 7. Bylaw No. 17 and Bylaw No. 17A are hereby repealed.
- 8. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of the passing thereof.
