

BYLAW NO. 2-81

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY TO PROVIDE FOR
THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE PUBLIC CEMETERY

The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as The Cemetery Bylaw.
2. a.) Cemetery: Means land within or outside the limits of the Town of Hudson Bay set apart for use as a place for the interment of the dead or in which human bodies have been buried, known as the Public Cemetery and described as follows:
"Part of the South-West Quarter of Section 21, Township Forty-five, Range 3, West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan."
b.) Director: Means any person designated by the Council of the Town of Hudson Bay.
c.) Town: Means the Town of Hudson Bay.
d.) Administrator: Means the Town Administrator of the Town of Hudson Bay.
e.) Grave Lot: Means a division of land in the Cemetery for the purpose of a single burial.
f.) Monument: Means any structure in the Cemetery erected or constructed on a lot as a memorial to the dead.
g.) Licensee: Means a person or persons who are responsible for a grave lot purchased in the Cemetery.

GENERAL RULES:

3. a.) The Town may grant a license to any person for the exclusive use of any Lot. The said license shall be subject to all provisions of this Bylaw and any amendments or regulations passed from time to time by the Council of the Town.
b.) License fee and all other charges for work done or services rendered shall be in accordance with rates set out in Schedule "A" attached to this Bylaw. The said schedule may be amended from time to time by Bylaw.
c.) Lots shall not be resold or transferred by the licensee. A licensee may surrender his license to the Town for any unused lot. The Town will refund to the original licensee the original purchase price of the license less a transfer fee of \$5.00.
d.) Whenever the remains of a grave lot or grave lots are removed, the grave space or spaces so vacated shall revert to the Town.
e.) No grave shall be used for any other purpose than the burial of the human dead.
f.) No person shall bury any dead body in the Cemetery until such person shall have complied with the provisions of the Public Health Act, the Vital Statistics Act and with the regulations issued thereunder and also with the provisions of this Bylaw.
g.) A person may reserve a grave lot or grave lots, by paying in full, the current purchase price as shown in Schedule "A" to this Bylaw.
h.) All persons, while in the Cemetery, shall conduct themselves in a quiet and orderly manner.
i.) Persons within the Cemetery shall use only the avenues, roads, walks and alleys, and no one is permitted to walk upon or across graves.

- j.) Persons visiting the Cemetery or attending funerals are strictly prohibited from picking flowers, wild or cultivated, breaking or injuring any tree, shrub or plant, or from writing upon, defacing, or injuring any memorial, fence or other structure within the Cemetery grounds.
- k.) Motor cars and vehicles in the Cemetery shall travel only on roadways provided for that purpose and shall not travel at a greater rate of speed than ten (10) miles per hour, except those vehicles used for the performance of maintenance.
- l.) No children under the age of twelve years shall be admitted to the grounds of the Cemetery unless they are accompanied by an adult person.
- m.) No person shall enter upon any portion of the Cemetery which is set apart for nursery grounds, garden or greenhouse, without first having obtained the consent of the Director.
- n.) No dogs shall be allowed in the Cemetery.

DUTIES OF DIRECTOR

- 4. a.) All the powers granted to the Director by this Bylaw shall be subject to the supervision and control of the Council through the Town Administrator.
- b.) The Director shall have charge of the Cemetery and control of all maintenance performed and such other works that are carried out at the Cemetery.
- c.) It shall be the duty of the Director to keep in good order all walks, paths, and driveways in the Cemetery, and to cut down all weeds, grasses and such trees and shrubs, or any part thereof, which are in his opinion injurious or unsightly.
- d.) It shall be the duty of the Director to determine the location of grave lots, and he shall stake a grave lot or grave lots out before the digging of such lot or lots. A minimum of 24 hours notice between Monday and Friday is required for the above.
- e.) It shall be the duty of the Director to determine the location where a monument or marker may be erected, and he shall stake such location prior to the erection thereof. A minimum of 24 hours notice between Monday and Friday is required for the above.

DUTIES OF ADMINISTRATOR

- 5. a.) All sale of grave lots in the Cemetery shall be made by the Administrator or his or her appointee and shall receive all moneys resulting from the sale of such grave lots.
- b.) All grave lots shall be described according to a Plan of Record in the Town Office. Suitable books of record shall be kept in the Town Office to record the description of each lot in the Cemetery, together with the name and address of the owner thereof, and such other records shall be kept to give a complete record of all business transacted in connection with the Cemetery. The records of the Cemetery shall be open to inspection during regular office hours.

INTERMENTS AND DISINTERMENTS

- 6.) a.) No interment of two or more bodies shall be made in one grave except in the case of Mother and Child or two infants buried in one casket.
- b.) No grave shall be less than six feet in depth from the surface of the ground.
- c.) No person other than a qualified Funeral Director shall have charge of the interment or disinterment of any human body.
- d.) Whenever a grave lot or grave lots is held jointly by two or more Parties, authority for interment in such grave lots will be accepted by the Town of Hudson Bay from any one of the said Parties or their Executors or Agents.

- e.) No interments shall be permitted in the Cemetery unless a proper burial permit is produced by the Party applying for the burial.
- f.) No disinterment shall be made without written authority from the Licensee of the grave lot in question or his Heirs, Executors or Assigns. No disinterment shall be made until a permit has been obtained from the Minister of Public Health of the Province of Saskatchewan. E

CARE OF GRAVES

- 7. a.) The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay shall assume the general care of the entire Cemetery. The Licensee of a grave lot shall observe all rules and regulations passed from time to time by Council for keeping the grave lots in order.
- b.) After the passing of this Bylaw, no borders, fences, railings, trellises, copings, hedges, grave covers, concrete or stone corners or iron posts shall be constructed or planted in or around any grave lot.
- c.) Borders, fences, railings, trellises, copings, hedges or grave covers in existence before the passing of this bylaw will be removed free of charge by the Town upon request in writing by the Licensee.
- d.) Any border, fence, railing, coping, hedge, grave cover or any other bounding or enclosing material erected before the passing of this Bylaw may be removed by the Town for reason of neglect or age if it becomes in a state of disrepair and the Licensee neglects to repair or remove the same.
- e.) The Director shall have authority to remove all floral designs, flowers, weeds, trees, shrubs, plants, or herbage of any kind from the Cemetery as soon as they become unsightly, dangerous, detrimental or diseased.

MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

- 8. a.) All monuments and markers shall be of granite, marble or stone.
- b.) All monuments and markers must be set at the head of a grave lot and shall be in a line designated by the Director.
- c.) No monument or marker shall be erected except on a concrete foundation of a minimum thickness of four (4) inches. The foundation shall be one inch above the ground surrounding the grave lot. The said foundation shall be of a dimension of five inches greater than the base of the monument on each of the four sides. The ground around the foundation shall be levelled to within one inch of the top of the foundation. Any excess material or debris must be disposed of to an area designated by the director.
- d.) No monument or marker shall be erected in the Cemetery until the design and description thereof has been approved by the Director and a written permit issued for the erection of such monument or marker.
- e.) Grave covers of any type or description and of any material shall not be permitted.

MONUMENTS IN DISREPAIR

- 9. a.) Should any tombstone, monument or other structure placed or arranged in the Cemetery be in a state of disrepair, the Town may have the said tombstone, monument or other structure removed from the Cemetery if the said Licensee does not have the same repaired.
- b.) The Director shall, from time to time, report to the Town Administrator and to the owners on the condition of any monument which is out of repair and it shall be the duty of the owner of such monument to repair same without delay, to the satisfaction of the Director.

- c.) Whenever any owner of a tombstone, monument or other structure neglects to make the required repairs or alterations after being given due notice by the Director so to do, the Director shall allow a period of three (3) months to elapse after the giving of the said notice and shall then have power to remove such tombstone, monument or other structure from the Cemetery or to repair it and charge the cost thereof to the owner and the cost may be recovered as a debt due by the owner, to the Town.
- d.) All notices required to be given to Licensees of grave lots or Owners of monuments or other Parties by this Bylaw may be delivered in writing by the Director or in writing, mailed postage paid, to the last known address of such Licensee or Owner or other Party and proof of such notice having been mailed, properly addressed with prepaid, or delivered shall be sufficient proof that such notice has been given.

TREES AND SHRUBS

- 10. a.) No person shall plant any trees, shrubs or any vegetation, or do work of any kind in the Cemetery without the permission of the Director.
- b.) If any tree or shrub situated on any grave lot or part thereof shall, in the opinion of the Director, become by means of its roots or branches in any way detrimental to any adjacent grave lot, path or driveway or to the general appearance of the Cemetery or dangerous or inconvenient to the public, the Director shall have the power to remove such tree or shrub or part thereof.

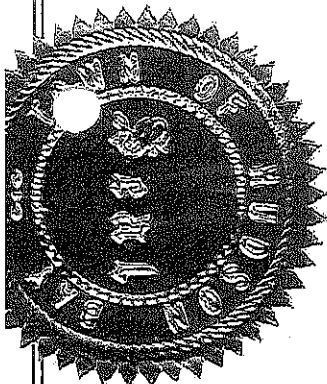
BURIAL OF INDIGENT POOR

- 11. a.) The Director shall furnish graves in the Cemetery, without charge, for the dead of indigent poor of any denomination who were residents in the Town at the time of death. Other Municipalities shall be held responsible for cost of graves for indigent poor who were residents of their Municipalities.

PENALTY

- 12. a.) Any person guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw or any part thereof, shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Hudson Bay.
- 13. Bylaw No. 14-73 and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed.


A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2-81 WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE PUBLIC CEMETERY

The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Bylaw No. 2 - 94 is hereby repealed.
- 2) Bylaw No. 2 - 81 is amended as hereinafter set forth.
 - A) Section 2. e) Shall read as follows:
Grave Lot: Means a division of land in the Cemetery for the purpose of burials.
 - B) Section 6. a) Shall read as follows:
The following interments may be allowed in each grave lot:
 - (1) One burial with the interment of up to two (2) cremative remains.
 - (2) Interment of two (2) cremative remains.
 - (3) Interment of Parent and Child or two infants in one casket.
 - C) Section 8. b) After the word Director add "an additional ground level marker will be allowed to identify each interment."
- 3) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.


