

BYLAW NO. 10-01

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY TO PERMIT OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES ON ROADWAYS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Under Section 9 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act, All Terrain Vehicles shall be permitted to operate on the travelled portion of the whole or any part of a roadway within the Town of Hudson Bay subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The operator is in the act of taking the most direct route to or from his point of origin or destination within the Town of Hudson Bay to or from the Town of Hudson Bay corporate limits.
 - a) The operator meets all applicable requirements of the All Terrain Vehicles Act and the Highway Traffic Act and any bylaw of the Town of Hudson Bay regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 1) An operator who does not comply with the conditions set forth in Section I shall be guilty of an offence and subject to the penalties set forth in the All Terrain Vehicles Act and the Highway Traffic Act or any bylaw of the Town of Hudson Bay regulating the operation of vehicles.
- 1) This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.
