

BYLAW NO. 2-74

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY TO PROVIDE
FOR THE REGULATIONS AND CONTROL OF SNOWMOBILES
WITHIN THE TOWN OF HUDSON BAY


The Council of the Town of Hudson Bay enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provision contained in subsection (1) of Section 21 of the Snowmobile Act, 1973, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 6:00 o'clock A.M. and 10:00 o'clock P.M.
 - (a) on all highways except on (1) Prince Street and Albert Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue.
 - (2) 5th Avenue between Prince Street and Albert Street.
 - (3) Patricia Street between 1st Avenue and 2nd Avenue.
 - (4) Lots 1-14, Block 3, Plan R3684, and ²⁶⁻⁴⁰ Block 31, Plan 65PA08279, and Block 24, Plan CT2889, being school owned property within the Town of Hudson Bay, and
 - (b) except on the Municipal Airport located on the N1/2 of Section 22, Township 44, Range 3, West of the 2nd Meridian and SE1/4 of Section 22, Township 44, Range 3, West of the 2nd Meridian.
2. Notwithstanding (1) it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the portions of provincial highway #9 and #3, only for the purpose of crossing said highway.
3. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Bylaw it shall be lawful for persons to use a snowmobile as a means of transportation to or from gainful employment.
4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of its approval by the Highway Traffic Board.
