

# *Hudson Bay Lions Club*

## *2018 Ice Fishing Rules*

### *For McBride Lake, SK*

1. Each angler must have in his/her possession a valid Saskatchewan fishing license where required and a Hudson Bay Lions Club Derby Ticket. The Hudson Bay Lions Club is not responsible for death, injury, damage liability, theft, or fire to any entrants. Each entrant, upon entering the derby will be, in effect, signing a waiver.
2. Only entrants are allowed in the fishing area. An official marking designated by the Hudson Bay Lions Club must be visible at all times on the entrant.
3. Practice fishing is not allowed at the derby location between 12:00 midnight and the beginning of the derby.
4. A legal fish must be caught between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. within the designated boundary. The largest fish by length of any species will be the winner. An entrant must be in the area of his/her line at all times while the line is in the water. This is a "Live Release Derby"; the use of a 5 gallon pail or other method of transporting the fish to the measuring station while immersed in water is suggested. Please bring your own pail. Any fish which are brought to the measuring station in a damaged state or dead will not be eligible for a prize. The decision of the derby officials is final. Prizes will be awarded at the completion of the derby. If not enough fish are caught, prizes will be drawn using a method decided by the Hudson Bay Lions Club. See Rule #14
5. Entrants with early bird tickets (purchased prior to March 26, 2018) may select their holes beginning at 10:00 a.m. All other entrants may select their holes at 10:30 a.m. There will be a 15, 10, and 5 minute warning sounded before start time.  
  
Start time will be announced by a method determined by the Committee. Any fish landed (out of the water) by 3:00 p.m. will be eligible.
6. The measuring station will be open throughout the contest. Fishermen are encouraged to enter their fish as soon as it is caught. Each person is responsible for his/her own catch. No other person may handle or touch a fish until it has been measured. In the event of a tie, the first fish measured shall be deemed the winner. Each person who catches a fish will accompany the fish to the measuring station and will present his/her SK fishing license and HB Lions Derby Ticket at this station. Entrant may win a prize with only their largest fish (one prize per person), pick a prize system. All prizes are new.
7. All questions or problems relating to the rules of this derby are to be referred to the Derby Committee. Their decision will be final. No fish houses, portable huts, or any coverings are allowed. No snowmachines or vehicles are allowed in the fishing area. Washroom facilities will be available. No littering.
8. No reserving holes for other entrants.
9. No electronic fishing Aids
10. Only one rod and line will be used per entrant per hole. On or before the day of the derby you may choose to purchase a second hole for \$30.00 up until 3:00 pm. You have the option to have both holes on the same spoke or a second hole drilled perpendicular to your existing hole (maximum of 5 Paces). **The second hole will be drilled by a Lions club member.** If your option is to have your extra hole on the same spoke you must use a predrilled hole. One prize per person.
11. Participants must land their own fish.
12. Anyone assisting in breaking derby rules may also have their registered fish, up to that point in the derby, disqualified.
13. All rules have loopholes. It is the intention of the Hudson Bay Lions Club to provide an honest sportsmanlike derby. In the interest of good sportsmanship, entrants are reminded that the "spirit of the rule" will prevail in all judgement cases.
14. If ice conditions are unsafe the derby will not be cancelled. Prizes will be drawn at 1:00 p.m. at derby location. Pick a prize method will be used for participants. For absentee winners the next highest valued prize available will be awarded.
15. Derby participants/Lions Club volunteers/family members are eligible for all draws.

16. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize is cash prize or alternate prize of ATV.
17. The Hudson Bay Lions Club will make every reasonable effort to notify prize winners. Section 13-D SLGA Raffle Terms & Conditions.
