AUGUST 21/21 STREET DANCE – COMMUNITY EVENT PERMIT & STREET CLOSURE

GRAD PARADE ROUTE – JUNE 28,2021 - AMENDMENT

Council approves the following amended temporary street closures to accommodate the Grad Walk/Parade to be held on Monday, June 28, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. for about an hour.

- Begin near the Parish Hall and walk down Churchill Street to Desrocher's Hotel.
- Get on floats near the parking lot near the former Post Review building parking lot on Railway Avenue.
- Drive down Main Street turning right at the Town Office.
- Turn left at Hamjea Street and drive in front of the school and daycare.
- Turn left at 4th Avenue and right on Churchill Street going past Churchill Place.
- Turn left at Let-us-Grow and left at Prince Street (driving by the hospital).

- Turn left at 4th Avenue and turn right onto Churchill Street going past McDonald's Family Foods and Craig's Home Hardware, and continue down Churchill Street to the former Post Review Parking lot on Railway Ave.
