**BCL – PROJECT ENGINEER’S REPORT – SPS & FORCE MAIN UPGRADES**

Council acknowledged receipt of BCL Project Engineer’s October 7, 2021 report for Lift Station #1 and Force Main projects. The sewer force main installation is 98% complete and contractor DC Trenching has de-mobilized from site. Work remaining includes connection to the sewage pumping station, which cannot be completed until the station has been backfilled. DC Trenching intends to return to finish this work as soon as site conditions allow. Work at Lift Station #1 continues to progress with Hipperson Construction as the contractor. Although progress is approximately four weeks behind the original January 31, 2022 completion date, due to some excavation obstacles, progress is being made.

**SUMA – REGIONAL MEETING – NOVEMBER 2, 2021 - VIRTUAL**

Information for the November 2, 2021 SUMA Virtual Regional Meeting was received and administration and Councillors were encouraged to register and attend.

**HB CONCERNED CITIZENS – COVID-19 MINISTER’S ORDER**

Council received correspondence and heard a delegation from a group of concerned citizens regarding the Province of Saskatchewan Minister’s Orders addressing the Covid-19 pandemic. Council acknowledged their presentation and concerns and responded appropriately that the Town of Hudson Bay is mandated and regulated under the Province of Saskatchewan, therefore it is out of their jurisdiction and encouraged any concerns be addressed to the Province of Saskatchewan.

**DISCRETIONARY USE APPLICATION – LOT 4, BLOCK 2, PLAN N665**

Approval was given for a single detached dwelling unit, subject to R-Residential District site regulations in the C1-Downtown Commercial District, at Lot 4, Block 2, Plan N665.

**LOT ACQUISITION PROPOSAL – LOTS 5 & 6, BLOCK 2, PLAN N665**

Council approved, in principle, a preliminary request to acquire Lots 5 & 6, Block 2, Plan N665 and negotiations will continue.
