Hudson Bay Lions Club 2023 Mcbride Lake Ice Fishing Derby McBride Lake, SK - March 25, 2023

\$75 per entry. Each entrant will be given a derby ticket with a unique number. Each angler must present their entry ticket upon entering the derby area.

Each angler must have in his/her possession a valid Saskatchewan fishing license, proof of age or Treaty ID as required to catch fish legally in the province of Saskatchewan.

The Hudson Bay Lions Club is not responsible for death, injury, damage liability, theft, or fire to any entrants. Each entrant, upon entering the derby will be, in effect, signing a waiver.

Only entrants are allowed in the fishing area. An official derby lanyard will be provided by the Hudson Bay Lions Club which must be visible at all times on the entrant.

Practice fishing on the day of the derby is not allowed at the derby location between 12:00 midnight and the beginning of the derby.

An entrant must always mind his/her line while the line is in the water. This is a "Live Release Derby". Once a fish is landed it must be submersed in water in a portable container (5 gallon pail or other) and transported to the nearest recording station. Derby officials will take a picture and record the time and entrants name for prize draw eligibility. Any fish brought to the recording station in a damaged state or dead will not be eligible for a prize. The decision of derby officials is final.

Size of fish does not matter!! Entrants who catch one of the first 40 fish (must be a recognized game fish, as per Saskatchewan sport fishing regulations) will all be entered in the random prize draw that will be held immediately following the derby. Each entrant may only enter one fish. Upon completion of the derby, the 40 eligible entrants will all be entered into a random prize draw (approved by SLGA). Each entrant will choose a random, sealed prize envelope. The order of envelope selection will be based on the 1st fish caught, 2nd fish caught, 3rd fish caught, and so on, to the 40th fish caught as determined by official recorded times. If there are two of more identical recorded times then a coin flip organized by derby officials will determine placement. Inside each envelope will be an identification of the prize awarded. If less than 40 fish are caught, a random draw of derby participants (present or not) will determine the remaining prize contestants.

The recording stations will be open throughout the contest. Fishermen are encouraged to enter their fish as soon as it is caught as the time of recording is important. Each person who catches a fish will accompany the fish to the measuring station and will present his/her legal proof to fish in Saskatchewan along with their HB Lions Derby Ticket at this station.

Registration starts at 10:30. Derby starts at 12:00 noon sharp. Upon entry, entrants must show their Hudson Bay Lions Ice Fishing Derby ticket, then will be given a derby lanyard and allowed to enter the designated derby fishing area. They may select their holes as they enter in a first come first serve basis (no early bird holes). Official starting time will be announced or signaled by a method determined by the Committee. No one can start fishing until the official start is announced. There will be 15, 10 and 5 minute warmings prior to the start time. All fish must be registered by 3:00 p.m. to be eligible. If 40 fish are registered before 3:00, the derby will end upon recording the 40^{th} fish and announced by derby officials.

Each entrant may fish in two holes. You must select a primary hole from the pre-drilled holes on a main spoke, and the second hole is one perpendicular and within 3 paces (approx. 3 meters) of your primary hole. If unsure, check with derby officials,

No fish houses, portable huts, or any coverings are allowed.

The use of snow machines or any other motorized vehicle, will not be allowed in the derby area, except for derby officials.

Participants must land their own fish. No reserving holes for other entrants. No electronic fish finders.

Anyone breaking or assisting in breaking derby rules will be disqualified from the derby. No refunds.

REMINDER: To be eligible for the prize draw a fish must be considered a Game Fish, as per the Saskatchewan sport fishing regulations.

All rules have loopholes. It is the intention of the Hudson Bay Lions Club to provide an honest sportsmanlike derby. In the interest of good sportsmanship, entrants are reminded that the "spirit of the rule" will prevail in all judgement cases.

If ice conditions are unsafe, the derby will **not be** cancelled. Prizes will be drawn at 1:00 p.m. at the derby location. All entrants will be entered into a random draw and the first 40 entrants drawn will be entered into the derby prize draw. The 40 entrants will then select one of the sealed prize envelopes. The order of selection will be the same as the order of draw (the first entrant selected will choose first, on so on). For absentee entrants a derby official will draw a prize envelope for them.

The Hudson Bay Lions Club will make every reasonable effort to notify prize winners. Individuals will have one year to claim their prize. If unclaimed after one year, prizes will be then given to another charitable group (approved by SLGA).

Prize list: (40 cash Prizes)

\$5,000 Grand Prize (1st place)

Prizes 2-20 will be a percentage of total ticket sales. Prizes 2 and 3 will be 7%, 4th and 5th will be 5%, 6th to 10th will be 2.5%, 11th to 20th will be 1.5%, and prizes 21 to 40 will be \$100 each.

Early bird Prize of \$500. To be eligible for the Early Bird prize draw, tickets must be purchased by March 20th, 2023. Draw will be made during the derby.
