GRAD 2024 PARADE REQUEST – JUNE 26, 2024

- Begin near the Parish Hall and walk down Churchill Street to Desrochers Hotel.
- Get on floats near the parking lot near the former Post Review building.
- Go down Main Street turning right on 2nd Avenue across from the Town Office.
- Turn left at Hamjea Street down to the school and daycare.
- Turn left on 4th Avenue and then right on Churchill Street going past Churchill Place.
- Turn left on 6th Avenue by Let-Us-Grow and another left onto Prince Street.
- Pass the hospital and turn left on 4th Avenue.
- Turn right on Churchill Street, pass Parkland Coop Grocery store and Craig Home Hardware and continue down Churchill Street returning back to the parking lot where the floats were originally parked.
